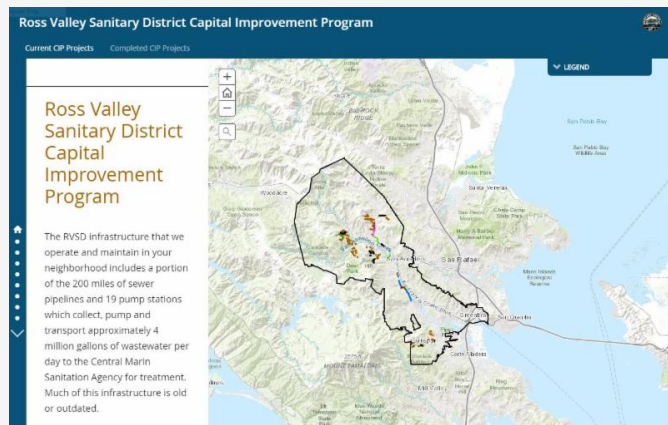

RVSD Board Approves Public Sewer Extension for Senior Housing Project:

At the [September 19 meeting](#), the RVSD Board approved a Public Sewer Extension for "Victory Village," a senior housing development planned at 2626 Sir Francis Drake Blvd. in Fairfax by Resources for Community Development. The Board also passed Resolution No. 18-1550, granting an 80 percent connection fee reduction in support of the project.

When complete, the project will offer 53 units of housing for low and extremely-low



income seniors.

Construction is anticipated to begin in December 2018.

Sewer Lateral Replacement Grant Funds Available: Do you want to receive assistance to replace your aging sewer lateral in FY 18/19? It's not too late! Over 270 customers participated in our Lateral Replacement Grant Program in FY 17/18 alone.

Nearly 20,000 linear feet of defective sewer laterals were replaced with the help of over \$530,000 in grant funds during that time. \$800,000 in grant funding has been budgeted for FY 18/19!

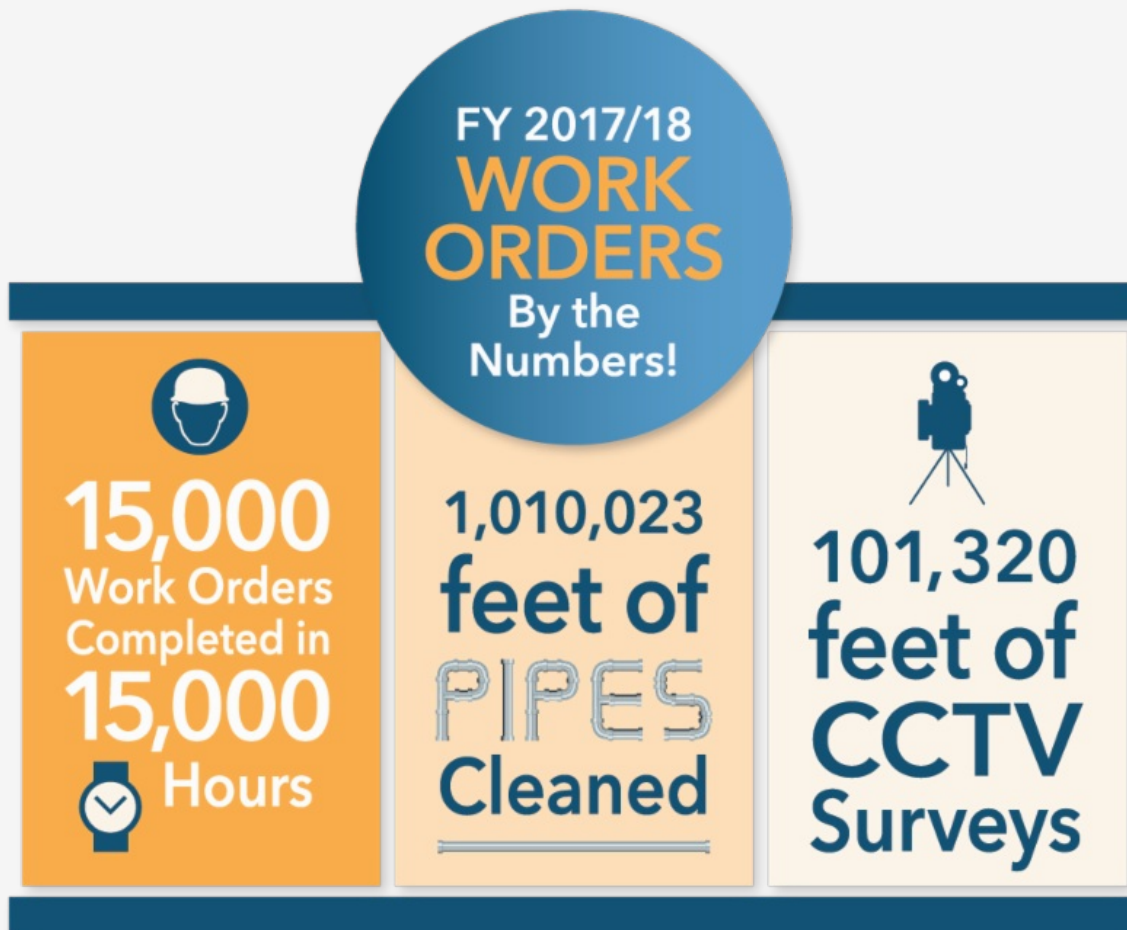
