**NOTICE INVITING BIDS**

Notice is hereby given that twelve individual sealed bids will be received by the Sanitary District No. 1 of Marin County ("District") in their office located at 2960 Kerner Blvd., San Rafael, CA 94901-5517, at any time prior to **the times and dates shown in the table below** for furnishing all labor, materials, equipment, and services for the construction of improvements designated as:

**Board Directed Repairs from December 21, 2011, Projects 1 through 12**

Individual bids will be received for each of the Projects 1 through 12, publicly opened, examined and declared on the date and time shown in the table below, and will be referred to the District Board of Directors for subsequent action.

A non-mandatory pre-bid conference will be held at **the time and dates shown in the table below for each Project**, at the offices of the District, 2960 Kerner Boulevard, San Rafael, California.

Although some projects may or may not share the same pre-bid and/or bid times and/or dates, each project is considered as separate and independent from all other projects. The bidder may submit bids for any one or more of the twelve projects, at the bidder's discretion.

The projects are generally described as follows: Pipe repair including sawcut, excavation, shoring, pipe repair, backfill, and asphaltic concrete trench plug as more fully described in the project-specific Specification Book, and appendix and plans/report attached thereto as defined below:

- Project No. 1 – Specification Book No. 1 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair at the pipe defect broken pipe, void visible.
- Project No. 2 – Specification Book No. 2 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair by replacement of 195 feet of pipe with multiple severe defects.
- Project No. 3 – Specification Book No. 3 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair at the pipe defect hole in pipe, void visible.
- Project No. 4 – Specification Book No. 4 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repairs at two pipe defects broken pipe, and hole in pipe, void visible.
- Project No. 5 – Specification Book No. 5 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair by replacement of 239 feet of pipe with multiple severe defects.
- Project No. 6 – Specification Book No. 6 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair by replacement of 197 feet of pipe with multiple severe defects.

- Project No. 7 – Specification Book No. 7 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair by replacement of 332 feet of pipe with multiple severe defects.
- Project No. 8 – Specification Book No. 8 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair at the pipe defect broken pipe, void visible.
- Project No. 9 – Specification Book No. 9 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair at the pipe defect broken pipe, void visible.
- Project No. 10 – Specification Book No. 10 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair by replacement of 376 feet of pipe with multiple severe defects.
- Project No. 11 – Specification Book No. 11 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair by replacement of 438 feet of pipe with multiple severe defects.
- Project No. 12 – Specification Book No. 12 dated January 20, 2012, the work described as pipe repair by replacement of 325 feet of pipe with multiple severe defects.

All of said work is to be done in accordance with the Specification Book as described above, at the places and in the particular locations, of the form, sizes and dimensions and of the materials, and to the lines and grades and at the elevations as shown on the Plans and Specifications made therefore and approved by the District.

Under California Laws and Regulations the District shall inform all prime contractors of public works, to the extent feasible of relevant public work requirements. Therefore the District hereby advises all bidders that the successful bidder shall:

1. Employ the appropriate number of apprentices on the job site as set forth in California Labor Code 1777.5;
2. Provide worker's compensation coverage, as set forth in California Labor Code Sections 1860 and 1861;
3. Keep and maintain the records of work performed on the public works project, as set forth in California Labor Code Section 1812;
4. Keep and maintain the records required under California Labor Code Section 1776 which shall be subject to inspection pursuant to California Labor Code Section 1776 and California Code of Regulations, Division 1, Chapter 8, Subchapter 3, Article 6, Section 16400 (e); and
5. Be subject to other requirements imposed by law.

Bidders are hereby notified that, pursuant to the provisions of California Labor Code, Sections 1770 et seq., the District has obtained from the Director of the Department of Industrial Relations, the general prevailing rate of per diem wages and the general prevailing rate for holidays, Saturdays and Sundays, and overtime work in the locality in which the work is to be performed for each craft, classification, or type of worker required to execute the contract. A

copy of said prevailing rate of the per diem wage is on file at the District offices, 2960 Kerner Blvd, San Rafael, CA 94901. Said prevailing rate of per diem wages will be made available to any interested party upon request, and a copy thereof shall be posted at the job site.

The District will not recognize any claim for additional compensation because of the payment by the Contractor of any wage rate in excess of the prevailing wage rates on file as aforesaid. The possibility of a wage increase is one of the elements to be considered by the Contractor in determining his/her or its Bid and will not, under any circumstances, be considered as the basis of a claim against the District on the Contract.

Bidders are hereby notified that if the Contract will be entered into or financed by or with the assistance of agencies of the United States, the District must comply with Federal prevailing wage requirements. A copy of the current prevailing rates under Federal law is included in the "Supplementary General Conditions" for this Project if so required by Federal law.

The successful Bidder and its subcontractors shall employ workers which consistently display and demonstrate proper moral, ethical and professional conduct to all fellow workers, employees and representatives of the District and other involved parties.

Pursuant to the provisions of California Labor Code Section 6707, each Bid submitted in response to this Notice to Contractors shall contain, as a Bid item, adequate sheeting, shoring, and bracing, or equivalent method, for the protection of life and limb in trenches and open excavation, which shall conform to applicable safety orders. By listing this sum, the Bidder warrants that its action does not convey tort liability to the District and the Design Consultant, and each of their employees, agents, and subconsultants.

Copies of the Contract Documents are now on file and available for public inspection at the District offices, 2960 Kerner Blvd, San Rafael, CA 94901 where they may be obtained for a non-refundable \$50.00 charge. Contract Documents will be mailed for an additional charge of \$10.00 per set.

Each Bid must conform and be responsive to the invitation, the Plans and Specifications, and all documents comprising the pertinent Contract Documents. Each Bid shall be presented under sealed cover and shall be accompanied by a certified check, cashier's check, cash or bidder's bond, made payable to the District, in an amount not less than ten (10) percent of the bid. The said check shall be given as a guarantee that the Bidder will execute the Contract in conformity with the form of agreement contained within the Contract Documents, and will furnish bonds and insurance policies as specified within ten (10) days after notification of the award of the Contract to the successful Bidder.

Addenda issued during the time of bidding shall be covered in the Contractor's Bid and shall become part of the Contract Documents.

Bidders shall develop and submit bids at their own expense. The District will not reimburse any costs associated with the development and submittal of any and all Bids.

The District reserves the sole right to reject any and all Bids and to waive any informality in a Bid.
