**RE: PRECONSTRUCTION PUBLIC OUTREACH NOTIFICATION
KENTFIELD FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT,
CORTE MADERA CREEK BERM PORTION**

This summer the Ross Valley Sanitary District (Sanitary District No. 1 or RVSD) is going to complete the replacement of the existing sanitary sewer pressure pipeline, called the Kentfield Force Main, which serves over 60 percent of the RVSD service area. RVSD is going to complete sliplining of the force main where the pipe is currently on top of the ground next to the trail adjacent to Corte Madera Creek and construct a parallel force main from Bon Air Road to Pump Station 15 (where the creek transitions from the earthen to concrete channel). Construction is expected to begin in early July, after the July 4th holiday, and continue through the end of November. The actual timing to start construction is dependent on the final acquisition of several permits to allow construction to occur along this portion of the force main alignment. The construction work also includes some localized excavations on South Eliseo Drive in June and July.

The public access trail on the berm will be closed to protect the public and the construction crews doing the pipeline construction, beginning on July 5, 2011. A detour will be reinstalled along the same alignment in 2010. A map showing the location of the trail closure is shown on the right.
