NOTICE OF SALE OF BONDS

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals or bids will be received by the Sanitary Board of Sanitary District No.1, Marin County, California, in the Town Hall at San Anselmo, at the hour of 8 o'clock P.M. on Tuesday, March 7th, 1922, for the purchase of the Sewer Bonds of said district to the amount of \$200,000.00

Said bonds are of the denomination of \$1,000 each, are dated April 1, 1922, and bear interest at the rate of six per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on the first days of April and October of each year. Commencing and continuing until the lowest numbers, five of said bonds shall be paid on April 1, 1923, and five of said bonds on the same day of each year thereafter until all of said bonds shall be paid.

The issuance of said bonds was authorized at an election held in said district on January 10th, 1922, by 405 affirmative votes against 164 negative votes.

All bids must be enclosed in a sealed envelope endorsed "Proposals for Bonds" and be accompanied by a certified check payable to said district in the amount of \$5,000, as a guarantee that the successful bidder will purchase said bonds if awarded to him, provided no certified check will be required on any bid made by or for the State of California.

The assessed value of all taxable property in the district in 1921, was \$2,990,945.00. The district has no indebtedness.

The Sanitary Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to give preference to unconditional bids.
