PROJECT INFORMATION SHEET

Laurel Grove Sewer Rehabilitation Project

As part of maintaining the 200 miles of collection sewer lines operated by Ross Valley Sanitary District (RVSD), a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is underway with construction projects needed to protect public health and the environment by reducing the risk of sewer overflows. Work to replace outdated system infrastructure and enhance system reliability is taking place in your neighborhood.

The **Laurel Grove Sewer Rehabilitation Project** will increase hydraulic capacity, reduce water infiltration and inflow, and provide needed structural rehabilitation in Laurel Grove Ave. (between Makin Grade and Sir Francis Drake Blvd.) and in Hanken Dr. & Quisisana Dr.

Night work on Sir Francis Drake Blvd. (in the easterly Laurel Grove Ave. intersection) is anticipated to begin Monday, July 6 and will take roughly three weeks to complete. Nightwork hours are Sunday through Thursday from 8 p.m. to 5 a.m.


The schedule is subject to revision to coordinate with the construction of the Marin County Upgrade the Drake Project. All other work is currently planned Monday through Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

The entire project is anticipated to be complete by the end of October 2020. Pavement restoration will meet County standards. These upgrades to old or outdated system infrastructure will enhance local wastewater system reliability and efficiency.

All RVSD projects and work activities being conducted adhere to the District's COVID-19 Exposure Control Plan to prepare for and, mitigate against the risk of COVID-19 exposure to the District's office staff and field workers.

RVSD PROJECT CONSTRUCTION WILL INCLUDE

- Structural rehabilitation in Laurel Grove Ave. (between Makin Grade and Sir Francis Drake Blvd.)
- Structural rehabilitation in portions of Hanken Dr. & Quisisana Dr.
- Excavation, shoring and backfill, saw cutting and lateral replacement, pipe and manhole repairs and pavement restoration.


