ORDINANCE NO. 34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 31 RELATING TO SEWER
USER SERVICE CHARGES

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF MARIN COUNTY DOES
ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1.: Section 6 (e) or Ordinance No. 31 is amended to read as
follows:

(e) High strength Sewage. For certain non-residential which
discharge sewage having significantly greater strength characteristics
than residential sewage, the total sewer user unit assignment shall be
determined by multiplying the units determined in Section 6 (c) above
by the Strength Factor shown.

<u>User</u>	<u>Strength Factor</u>
Market with garbage disposals	2.34
Mortuaries	2.34
Restaurant/Cafes	2.34
Bakeries	2.34

For other users, if any, discharging high strength sewage, the
Strength Factor shall be as determined by the District Engineer. If
any of such users believe that their particular operations do not
result in sewage of significantly greater strength than residential
sewage, such user, may request that the District Engineer review their
operations with the final determination as to the appropriate charge
being made by the Board of Directors of Sanitary District No. 1. The
cost of such examination shall be borne by the user requesting the
review.


Section 2.: This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and
effect on July 1, 1985 after publication in the Independent Journal, a
newspaper of general circulation in the district.
