ORDINANCE No. 53

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 414 OF THE SANITARY CODE WITH REFERENCE TO
BACKWATER PREVENTION DEVICES**

WHEREAS, the Sanitary Code of Sanitary District No. 1 of Marin County contains Section 414, providing for Backwater Prevention Devices; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of Sanitary District No. 1 of Marin County has determined that it is in the interest of public health, safety and general welfare to amend Section 414 of the Sanitary Code to provide for certain increased inspections and other processes to ensure the fullest possible opportunity for the installation of effective backwater devices, as more particularly defined in Section 414 of the Sanitary Code; and

WHEREAS, the Sanitary District No. 1 of Marin County Board of Directors conducted a duly noticed public hearing regarding this Ordinance on April 2, 2002, having received testimony and other evidence regarding this Ordinance:

IT IS NOW THEREFORE ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

1. Section 414 of the Sanitary Code shall be revised to include, following the second sentence of said section, the following language:

“Furthermore, should the District make a determination, based upon, without limitation, observable property conditions, that installation of a backwater prevention device, check valve, or other device is warranted, such device shall be installed, pursuant to the provisions set forth below.”
