
AN ORDINANCE OF SANITARY DISTRICT NO. 1 OF
MARIN COUNTY REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 27,
"AN ORDINANCE DECLARING EMERGENCY, PRO-
HIBITING CONNECTION TO CERTAIN SANITARY
SEWERAGE FACILITIES AND PROVIDING FOR ITS
ENFORCEMENT"

County, California, does ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. Ordinance No. 27, entitled, "An Ordinance Declaring
Emergency, Prohibiting Connection to Certain Sanitary Sewerage
Facilities and Providing for Its Enforcement", adopted by the
Sanitary Board of said District on April 20, 1967, be, and it is
hereby, repealed.

Sec. 2. Upon adoption, this ordinance shall be entered in
full in the minutes of this Board and shall be published once in
the Fairfax Reporter, a newspaper published in said District and
be effective upon the expiration of one (1) week from the date of
said publication.
