

Large Diameter Gravity Sewer Project II-3A Ross Common / Upper Shady Lane

As part of maintaining the 200 miles of collection sewer lines operated by Ross Valley Sanitary District (RVSD), a Capital Improvement Program (CIP) is underway with construction projects needed to protect public health and the environment by reducing the risk of sewer overflows.

Work to replace outdated system infrastructure and enhance system reliability is taking place in your neighborhood.

The **Ross Common / Upper Shady Lane Sewer Improvements** will replace old or outdated system infrastructure and enhance local wastewater system reliability and efficiency. Construction to improve system performance during wet weather will involve rehabilitation of 2,300 linear feet (LF) of sewer pipeline ranging in size from 8 to 28 inches in diameter and associated structures. The project is being completed at a cost of \$4 million.

The project will take place within two project areas located in the Town of Ross: the Bolinas Ave./Upper Shady Ln. area (Upper Shady) and the Lagunitas Rd./Ross Common (Ross Common).



PROJECT CONSTRUCTION WILL INCLUDE

- Sanitary sewer replacements on public and private property.
- Sewer pipeline rehabilitation via pipe bursting (~1,420 LF), open-cut removal and replacement (~650 LF) and slip lining (~190 LF), with bypass pumping of sanitary sewer flow.
- Excavation, shoring and backfill, saw cutting, pipe and manhole repairs and new manholes.
- Landscape and pavement restoration.


